You can always do as below. I've set this out in case you want to include these instructions on your website (to save you the bother).

It works fine if you go first to the 'Security & Privacy' preference pane in System Preferences, and on the 'General' tab, choose the 'Anywhere' radio button (you'll be presented with a confirmation dialog as second screenshot below - obviously click on the 'Allow From Anywhere' button.)





You may have to authenticate fist by clicking on the padlock icon at the bottom left of the pane and, of course, you can always return to your earlier preference after installation of your plugin(s) if you want to.

I am releasing a new version of my MailFollowUp plugin. The update includes the following changes:
